

Spring Junk Pickup

The Spring Junk Pickup will be held on Monday (Date) Sponsored by the Johns Woods HOA, this event occurs every two years to facilitate spring cleaning. Following are three ways you can dispose of your unneeded items:

1. JWHOA Junk Pick Up on Monday (Date).

Place your items out between 6 AM and 8 AM the day of the pickup for collection by Republic Services. **To avoid overnight scavengers, please do not place material at curbside prior to 6 AM on Monday.** Pickup by Republic will begin at 8 AM.

Place your material as near the street as possible, not in the street. Your driveway is your private property and anyone there without your invitation is trespassing.

Do not place anything at curbside that you do not want collected. i.e. Containers.

This pickup is for John's Woods owners only. Removal of any material by anyone other than Republic Services is theft from private property, and should be reported to the police.

Please print page three of this notice and secure it in plain sight to your material for pickup.

MATERIALS ACCEPTABLE FOR PICKUP:

- Household furniture, furnishings, shelving, racks, broken implements, tools, sports equipment, and other junk.
- Scrap lumber less than 4 inches thick and six feet long. Bundle the wood and secure with heavy twine.
- Household appliances. Except air conditioners, freezers and refrigerators.
- Brick and concrete less than 60 lbs per unit.
- Wheel rims, auto parts and accessories

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS:

- Lawn and yard debris.
- Medical waste of any kind.
- Batteries.
- Garbage.
- Computer equipment, TV sets.
- Any equipment that has, or does, contain oil or gas. No propane tanks.
- Household hazardous waste; paint, petroleum, pesticides, florescent lamps, etc. Look for the warning words on the product labels: toxic, caution, corrosive, combustible, poison, flammable and dangerous.
- Automobile, RV, and truck tires

If you have hazardous waste, please contact Metro at 503-234-3000 for disposal information.

2. Donate Your Used Items to a Charitable Organization.
